## Round Rock Convention and Visitors Bureau



### Sports

- Round Rock, the “Sports Capital of Texas,” has the capability to host youth, amateur and recreational sports events.
- Round Rock is the home of the Round Rock Express, the Triple-A affiliate of the Houston Astros. The Express home games are played on the Dell Diamond, which holds 8688 fixed seats and 3000 lawn seats.
- Round Rock has three parks: Old Settlers Park, Northeast Metropolitan Park, and Williamson County Park. Old Settlers, Round Rock’s largest park, claims 570 acres including baseball, softball, football, soccer, tennis, sand volleyball and disc golf amenities.
- Round Rock features seven golf courses for all skill levels including an 8,427 foot course, one of the biggest in the U.S.
- The city boasts 30 full-size soccer fields, 15 baseball fields, 15 softball fields, 3 football fields, 14 tennis courts and 3 miles of trails.
- Round Rock holds amateur flag football, cricket, rugby, paintball, football and lacrosse events.
- Round Rock hosts Road Rash, an annual in-line skating competition ranked 5th in the nation.

### Conventions and Meetings

- Round Rock can host up to 500-person events.
- Round Rock’s many spacious venues include the United Heritage Center, a 10,000 square foot building that can accommodate up to 500 people; Williamson Conference Center, with 15,000 square feet of meeting space and Austin Marriott North, which has 14,000 square feet of flexible meeting space and eight executive boardrooms.
- Round Rock also has facilities for smaller, more intimate meetings like the Brushy Creek Community Center, Rabb House and Kinningham House.
- The Round Rock Library, with 43,000 square feet on two levels, is also available for events.

### Family Vacations

- Round Rock offers visitors a choice of 2,000 welcoming hotel rooms.
- Round Rock’s brand new Rock’N River Family Aquatic Center, located within Old Settlers Park, opened in June 2006. The 40,481 square foot water park features a lazy river, crazy slides and a water playground.
- The newly-opened Round Rock Premium Outlets shopping center features 120 designer and name-brand outlet stores as well as a 14-screen, state-of-the-art movie theater.
- The IKEA in Round Rock presents 50 different room settings, three complete homes, a supervised children’s play area and a 250-seat restaurant serving Swedish specialties and American dishes.
- Round Rock’s 150 fine and casual dining locations offer American, Asian, Italian, Mexican and Tex-Mex cuisine, bakeries, coffee shops, delis, barbeque and seafood.
- Round Rock was recently named the 13th safest city in the U.S. according to a Morgan Quitno Press national crime survey of cities with populations exceeding 75,000.
